

As advertised in the Journal Herald, the Packer Township Supervisors held a special meeting on Monday, September 15, 2025 at the township building. Bob Selert called the meeting to order and roll call was taken. All were present.

The meeting was opened to the floor. There were no comments.

Old Business – Bob Selert made a motion to accept Anthracite Waste Services bid for 5 years at a cost of \$810,000. Susie Gerhard seconded the motion and Terry Davis agreed. Vote 3-0 Quarterly bills will be reduced to \$90 for a savings of \$100/year. Susie asked AWS if people want smaller cans can they get them. The rep with AWS said they would and it would be at no charge. The cans will be delivered 1-2 months in advance of the new year. Pick-up day will remain Thursday but if there are any changes AWS will take care of mailings and notify the supervisors. Bob confirmed that AWS will have a number for residents to call to schedule bulk pick-ups or report a problem.

New Business – Bob Selert made a motion to approve the request of the Weatherly Area Community Library to hold a basket raffle in the garage on October 3rd and 4th. Terry Davis seconded the motion and Susie Gerhard abstained. Vote 2-0

Tom Russell asked if NorthPoint will be at the October meeting to make a presentation. Bob responded that NorthPoint was asked to make a public presentation before any application is submitted. Currently we have not gotten confirmation that they will make a presentation at the October meeting. Another resident notes that NorthPoint will have a presentation at Banks Township (Treschow) on September 30th at 6 pm possibly in the old fire house. Tony Caso asked if NorthPoint is the same outfit that bought 750 acres on Rt. 903 near Penn's Peak. Bob believes it is not the same.

Stephanie will prepare the contract with Anthracite Waste Services.

Bob Selert made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Susie Gerhard seconded the motion. Terry Davis agreed. Vote 3-0

The meeting was adjourned at 7:14 p.m. Nine residents attended the meeting.
